Key Points of the Library Department’s Proposal:

- Branch libraries to resume service on Mondays
- Proposed schedule is similar to our current operating schedule with the addition of Mondays
- Friday would be a shorter day to accommodate a full day on Mondays, a busier day
- The proposed schedule returns staff to an alternating Friday/Saturday schedule which was in place in branches prior to March 20, 2010

Current Schedule:

Branch Libraries currently have 36 core service hours per week. In addition, four of the 35 branch libraries (City Heights/Weingart, La Jolla/Riford, Point Loma/Hervey & Serra Mesa-Kearny Mesa) have private funding for 4 hours on Sundays.

- Monday- CLOSED
- Tuesday- 12:30 to 8:00 PM
- Wednesday- 12:30 to 8:00 PM
- Thursday- 9:30 to 5:30 PM
- Friday- 9:30 to 5:30 PM
- Saturday- 9:30 to 2:30 PM
- Sunday- Hours at the 4 branches receiving private funding- 1:00 to 5:00 PM

Proposed Schedule:

- Monday 9:30 to 5:30 PM
- Tuesday 12:30 to 8:00 PM
- Wednesday 12:30 to 8:00 PM
- Thursday 9:30 to 5:30 PM
- Friday 12:30 to 5:30 PM
- Saturday 9:30 to 2:30 PM

Staffing Key Points:

- The department has approximately 38 vacancies. For the new schedule of added hours, it is estimated an additional 22.8 FTE in limited hourly staff would need to be hired
- The proposed schedule returns staff to an alternating Friday/Saturday schedule which was in place in branches prior to March 20, 2010
