# **Current Schedule:**

Branch Libraries currently have 36 core service hours per week. In addition, four of the 35 branch libraries (City Heights/Weingart, La Jolla/Riford, Point Loma/Hervey & Serra Mesa-Kearny Mesa) have private funding for 4 hours on Sundays.

- Friday 12:30 to 5:30 PM
- Saturday 9:30 to 2:30 PM

#### Staffing Key Points:

- The department has approximately 38 vacancies. For the new schedule of added hours, it is estimated an additional 22.8 FTE in limited hourly staff would need to be hired
- The proposed schedule returns staff to an alternating Friday/Saturday schedule which was in place in branches prior to March 20, 2010
